Selva's Story

Craniofacial disfigurement can take a lot from us. It can dramatically change our lives, whether it's from birth or it occurs later in life as a result of trauma, accident or cancer.

Selva (pictured) was born with a rare craniofacial cleft, a severe deformity of the face and head that affects both bones and soft tissue. Basic functions like eating, sleeping, breathing and talking were impossibly difficult for Selva.

Thanks to a chance meeting with Prof.
David David AC at a clinic in Malaysia, Selva travelled to Australia at age 1 for his first surgery. Selva has since had over 15 surgeries. With the right support and a healthy dose of willpower, Selva now lives a full life with his wife Fotini and three children in Australia.

The work of Craniofacial Australia is important to Selva, because he knows that it is life-changing.

"The Foundation helps people with facial anomalies to journey through the reconstruction phase and the other part is how to deal with it. The surgery part is just the first step and a small part if you look at it. The other part is going into society and taking all of those steps, this is the bigger part."



#### **Meet the Researcher**

Seb Dworkin, Assoc. Prof. La Trobe University, Victoria

In my lab, we use advanced research techniques to try and better understand some of the genetic and non-genetic causes that contribute to defects in children. Importantly, we try and find new ways to stop them from happening or make them less severe. Our ultimate goal is to give these kids that will be born with debilitating defects a much better and healthier start to life.

Craniofacial Australia funds training programs for health professionals to develop best-practice treatment and rehabilitation for persons with craniofacial deformities and injuries.

To achieve this goal, we fund the following training programs:

### **Indonesian Lecture Series**

Some of the most vulnerable patients with the rarest and most extreme deformities are located overseas.

Craniofacial Australia delivers weekly online training and education sessions to Dr. Soetomo Hospital and Airlangga University Medical School in Indonesia to up-skill medical professionals and ultimately, better outcomes for patients that come into their care.

# **Bristol Cleft Fellowship**

We fund an annual Fellowship based at University Hospital Bristol and Weston General Hospital (UK). This fellowship gives a budding surgeon hands-on training and contributes to research that investigates environmental and biological causes of Cleft Lip and Palate.

# Did you know?

In 1983, the Apex Foundation alongside other service clubs, raised almost \$1 million to fund craniofacial surgery in Adelaide. This established the Foundation to continue to raise funds for patients and families in Australia and overseas.



# Writing your will

There are three types of gift you can leave in your Will:



# A residuary gift

This is a percentage share of your total estate (everything that you own that is of value) after all other payments (debts, tax, etc) have been deducted. A residuary gift will keep its value over time and is not affected by inflation.



# A pecuniary gift

A fixed amount of money that you leave in your Will. It is important to review pecuniary gifts regularly, as their value can be reduced by inflation.



# A specific gift

A particular item of value (personal possessions, property or shares) is left in your Will.

If you are interested in other types of gifts to leave in your Will, we recommend talking to your solicitor.

# **Writing** a Will

Writing a Will and keeping it updated will ensure you have peace of mind that your loved ones will be looked after.

While not a legal requirement, using a qualified solicitor to write your Will mitigates the occurrence of errors or oversights, which can be stressful for the people closest to you.

We understand that your Will is private. It is your choice whether you choose to tell us that you left a gift in your Will to support our life changing work. However if you wish to let us know, we can do more to show you the difference that your gift will make.

# Words matter

If you wish to support the life-changing work of Craniofacial Australia, legal clarity makes things easier for those we leave behind.

Below is a guide for wording. You can use this when you visit your solicitor:

I (YOUR NAME) give \* to THE AUSTRALIAN CRANIO-MAXILLO FACIAL FOUNDATION (Craniofacial Australia) of 204 Melbourne Street, North Adelaide (ABN: 29 008 155 780) in the State of South Australia for its general purpose and I declare that the receipt of its Treasurer, Group Accountant or other authorised officer, shall be sufficient discharge to my executors.

\*Insert the details of the residue, estate, particular asset or sum of funds you wish to donate to Craniofacial Australia.

# Already have a Will?

Take a copy of your Will wording to your solicitor and they will update your existing Will according to your wishes.

Leaving a gift in your Will is life changing. When we join forces, we can make the impossible possible.

Thank you for sharing our vision of providing disadvantaged children and adults with a second chance at life. Your special gift could make a difference to people who, through genetic birth anomalies or serious accidents/trauma, can gain control of their lives.

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
